

IMPACT AID INFORMATION

For Parents of Beauregard Parish Students

YES! A parent/guardian is active duty military or reserves

YES! We live on federal property

(Fort Polk, DeRidder or Merryville Housing Authority, other)

YES! A parent/guardian works on federal property

(Any job at Fort Polk – Civil Service, Civilian, Contracted, etc, Any US Post Office, USDA, any position on an Indian reservation, etc)

If you answered “Yes” to any of the above statements, please fill out the [2012-13 Impact Aid Survey](#) and return it to your child’s school. Only one survey per household needs to be returned. Surveys are due Wednesday, November 14, 2012.

Impact Aid is a federal program that provides funds to school systems based on numbers of federally-connected students in the district. Impact Aid was designed to assist local school districts that have lost property tax revenue due to the presence of tax-exempt federal property, or that have experienced increased expenditures due to the enrollment of federally-connected children.

Federally-connected children are those who live on a military base, whose parents are active duty military or reserves, who live on other federal property like a housing authority, or whose parents work on federal property, including contractors and civilians who work at Fort Polk or other federal property.

The Beauregard Parish Schools system provides surveys in November of each school year to determine the number of students who meet the program’s criteria. The survey must be completed and signed each year by the parent. Information provided on the survey is treated confidentially. The funds received from Impact Aid benefit the schools in our parish.
